The gates will open Saturday morning at 6 AM for those classes that race on Saturday with the first practice session starting at 8:00 AM. To accommodate the stock car program that races on Saturday evening all vehicles and trailers must be out of the racing paddock by 3 PM.

The gates will open again on Sunday morning at 6 AM with the first practice session starting at 9 AM. The full race schedule is available on the BSRKC website.

There is no camping allowed on the property, a full service campground is located just a short drive north of the track. As the racing will end early on Saturday everyone will have lots of time to enjoy the many amenities the campground has to offer. Information on the camp ground is available at the BSRKC website.
