BSRKC Announces 2009 Classes and Schedule, Opens Number Registration, and Sets 2010 Direction

As a part of its ongoing focus on putting the needs of the racers first, the Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship Series is pleased to announce its 2009 class structure. Number registration for 2009 is also now available. By taking these steps at this early date, BSRKC is able to provide karters with plenty of time to prepare for the new season. Following the tremendous success of the 2008 BSRKC series, the principals and organizers of the series are looking forward to producing even larger events in 2009.

The official BSRKC classes for 2009 will be:

- Honda classes: Novice, Junior Lite, Junior Heavy, Senior Lite, Senior Heavy, Masters;
- Rotax Max Challenge classes: Rotax Junior, Rotax Senior, Rotax DD2;
- Other classes: Rotax Micro Max, Rotax Mini Max, TAG/Rotax and ICC.

No major rule changes are anticipated for any of these classes, and we intend to publish more detailed class specifications as soon as possible following the RMC meetings at the Rotax Max Challenge Grand Final in Italy.

BSRKC is committed to running all of the official classes in 2009 subject to the receipt of sufficient number registrations by March 1, 2009. In the event that a class does not have at least 10 registrations by that date, BSRKC may at its discretion drop the class.

BSRKC has also included some “provisional” classes in the 2009 class structure in response to expressions of interest. At present, these classes include Cadet, Junior Medium, Senior Medium, TAG Novice and TAG Junior.

Any provisional class will only be included in an event if there are at least ten registered entries for that event in that class. Please note that registering a kart number for the series does not constitute event registration.

BSRKC may also add other classes at its discretion if sufficient interest is expressed.

BSRKC is pleased to present its tentative 2009 schedule, and has made the schedule available on the BSRKC web site at <http://www.bsrkc.com>. Stay tuned for details as the finishing touches are applied to the schedule.

At this time, BSRKC is also pleased to provide a statement of direction regarding its class structure for 2010. BSRKC intends to include all the 2009 official classes in its 2010 class structure, and will continue the 2009 provisional classes if sufficient participation levels occur. This provides Ontario karters with an unprecedented opportunity to plan their equipment two full seasons ahead without worrying whether the classes they choose will disappear from the BSRKC series.

Kart number registration for the 2009 BSRKC series is now available. All kart numbers will be issued on a first-come, first-serve basis.
