## **BRIAN STEWART RACING KARTING CHAMPIONSHIP CHANGES VENUE FOR ROUND TWO**

BSRKC will return to the 3S Go Karts facility in Sutton, Ontario for the second round of regional racing on June 5-6-7.

Sutton West, Ontario – The Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship notifies all series competitors and supporting clubs that the location for round two has been reset for 3S Go Karts. The change in venue was the result of extenuating circumstances and for reasons beyond the control of the BSRKC Steering Committee. For this reason it has been decided to change the venue for this event. While the notice is short, Series Officials worked every possible scenario in close cooperation with Cameron Motorsports representatives to resolve all issues in order to proceed as scheduled.

“This is very unfortunate and we apologize for the short notice and the inconvenience this may cause the many competitors and families that support the BSRKC,” comments Series Officials.

The race will now be held at 3-S Go Karts, host location for round one, which saw 16 classes compete over three days of action. A new track configuration has been set for this event and the Committee is hard at work preparing for the changes. The success of the BSRKC Series continues because of the involvement all of the tracks, clubs and participants in the decisions and choices. With 275 entries competing at the first race, the BSRKC intends to keep the momentum going. Series officials look forward to seeing everyone in Sutton.

Reached by phone, Series Official Mike Preston had the following statement: “We needed to do the right thing for the majority of drivers. Efforts were made on both sides to resolve outstanding issues, but the deadline could not be met.”

Keep an eye on the BSRKC website for further announcements related to this event. The 3-S Go Karts facility is available for practice everyday this week. The Simcoe Kart Club and the Waterloo Regional Kart Club have worked in tandem to make this series competitive, enjoyable and rewarding.
