BSRKC 2010 KART NUMBER REGISTRATIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Only two days after the end of the 2009 series, the BSRKC Series has already received two kart number registrations for the 2010 racing year. Taegen Poles has reserved kart #7 in Rotax Mini Max, while Andre Fiorini, undecided about whether to move up a class in 2010, has reserved kart #7 in both Honda Novice and Junior Lite. More inquiries are arriving every day.

Racing numbers are reserved on a *first come, first served* basis. Karters wishing to reserve their numbers for this coming year are welcome to mail in their kart number registration forms at any time.

The \$5.00 fee per kart number registered will save you any disappointment and additional costs in replacing numbers on race day. Effective for 2010, all numbers must be clearly marked on all four sides of the kart. Numbers altered in any way or with tape will *not* be acceptable.
