Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship Invades Point Pelee Karting
*Ontario karting series travels to Canada's most southern track
for a full weekend of action*

Sutton, ON – The Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship continues its 2010 season this weekend at the Point Pelee Karting facility in Leamington, Ontario. This will be the first time this season where all twelve official BSRKC classes will compete on the same weekend. After successful events at Sutton, Kawartha and Innisfil, this marks the fourth of eight events this season. The series returns to Leamington for the third time in five year's, as PPK was part of the series inaugural season as well as in 2008.

The event will officially kick off on Friday with a full day of practice for the twelve official classes plus two club classes taking part: Honda Cadet and TaG Senior/TaG Masters. The track selection for this weekend's race is the Lemans counter-clockwise layout, which includes all of Leamington's exciting features. Continually stepping up to support karting in the Southern Ontario area, CF Groups and Quinlan Inc. will be this weekend's title sponsors. Also kicking in to support the weekend is Jose's Noodle Factory in uptown Leamington and Freddy's Restaurant, located just down the road from the track.

“We are very excited to be hosting the BSRKC this weekend in Leamington,” commented PPK's Jason Papp. “We really appreciate those who are making the trip down, and I can assure them, it will be a great weekend.”

Saturday will feature a full slate of racing as the Honda Cadet and Jr. Medium classes will line up with the 2-cycle classes of: Rotax DD2, Rotax Mini-Max, Senior TaG/Masters TaG, Rotax Junior, TaG Junior and F125 Shifter. Following the conclusion of the event, practice will be available for the remaining Honda classes along with the Rotax Senior class on Saturday evening.

Six Honda classes highlight Sunday's schedule as Novice, Junior Lite, Junior Heavy, Senior Lite, Senior Heavy and Masters will compete along with the Rotax Senior class. An official schedule can be found on the BSRKC website.

This weekend's race will be the midway point of the 2010 BSRKC season and the first of three events in the month of July. Following Leamington, the WRKC hosts the four-cycle classes at Flamboro Speedway on July 10 and 11, where the club has extended a special invitation to the F125 Shifter class. Then all the classes reconvene for the prestigious 'Bear Hunt' races at Shannonville Motorsports Park on July 28-August 1.
