Exciting racing and a challenging track, now you know why Flamboro Speedway will be the place to be for 4 stroke racers on July 10th and 11th for round 3 of the 2010 Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship (BSRKC).

The 2010 BSRKC season is well under way with the 4 stroke racers having completed two races of the five race series. This weekend's event at Flamboro Speedway will be very important for those that are chasing the coveted Stewart Cups. Novice class points leader Austin Bisschop and Masters class points leader Jake Collison hope to use their home track knowledge to distance themselves from their competitors. Cory Cacciavillani and Greg Rempel look to resume their close battle for the lead in the Senior Lite class. T.J. Marshall will need a good finish to stay in the hunt if he is going to repeat as the Senior Heavy champion for 2010. It won't be easy for any of the point leaders as there are sure to be full grids in every class.

The Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship (BSRKC) organizers, series presenting sponsors MG Tires, A to Z Capital, and Defrancesco Racing along with the Waterloo Regional Karting Club have been working hard for a number of months to make sure this will be a great event for all racers. The Flamboro facility features grandstand seating with a great view of the whole track, a snack bar, and plenty of parking for racers and spectators. Because space will not be an issue the fee for trailers over 30 feet in length

has been waived for this event. As has become the tradition with all BSRKC events those that finish in the top 3 will be rewarded with great prizes, and the top five will receive a trophy as has always been the practice at WKRC events.

The track gates will open on Saturday morning at 6:00 AM with practice for all classes from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM. To accommodate the stock car program that races on Saturday evening all vehicles and trailers must be out of the racing paddock by 3:00 PM. The gates will open again on Sunday morning at 6:00 AM with the first practice session starting at 9:00 AM. The full race schedule is available on the BSRKC website. The club has made arrangements to have the race track open for parking of trailers in the pit area from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM on Friday evening.

There is no camping allowed on the property. A full service campground is located just a short drive north of the track. As the racing will end early on Saturday, everyone will have lots of time to enjoy the many amenities the campground has to offer. Information on the camp ground is available at the BSRKC website.
