BSRKC 2010 Season Starts May 16 in Sutton

Simcoe Kart Club will host the first round of the 4 cycle classes racing in the 2010 BSRKC Series this Sunday, May 16 at 3-S Go Karts in Sutton. Full details including downloadable entry form, event schedule, accommodations and pre-tech forms are located in the 2010 Schedule page on the BSRKC.com website.

The track will be set up in the Villeneuve configuration and raced counter-clockwise. Open practice is available all week at 3-S Go Karts. The official controlled practice is on Saturday for both four cycles and any two cycles looking to put in some practice before the upcoming Kawartha Speedway event. Parking areas are assigned according to size and anyone wishing to drop off their trailer before the weekend may do so Monday to Wednesday before 8:00 pm, Thursday before 6:00 pm, Friday and Saturday before 8:00 pm. Each entrant is entitled to one free 10' x 30' parking spot.

AIM Sports & Mike McKnight, 401 Dixie Nissan/Infiniti & Peter Geer, and KnK Karts North America & Kevin Barrick, are the event sponsors. Trophies and prize cheques will be awarded to the top 3 in each of the six classes in the amount of \$175.00, \$75.00 and \$50.00. Mr. Brian Stewart will be presenting the trophies and the prize cheques as well as conducting the draws for all of the prizes.

The six 4 cycle classes competing on Sunday are Novice, Junior Lite, Junior Heavy, Senior Lite, Senior Heavy and Masters. It will be interesting to see how the year transpires for last year's champions and whether or not they will retain their titles or capture new ones. Clay Van Eerd, Scott Nagel, Tristan Gill, Jonathon Treadwell, T. J. Marshall and Jake Collison will have to face new challengers each starting their quest for the Stewart Cups.

The Simcoe Kart Club Executives and Directors together with Mr. Stewart and the Waterloo Regional Kart Club, look forward to welcoming all ASN Canada affiliated kart club members this weekend at 3-S Go Karts in Sutton. The BSRKC formula has been in place since 2006. The formula has been tweaked over the years.
