BSRKC Releases Official 2010 Schedule

The Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship announces final version of 2010 schedule with tracks, format and dates

Sutton West, Ontario – The Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship is pleased to announce the finalized 2010 race schedule and event locations. The series will continue to run a split schedule with three four-cycle-only and three two-cycle-only race weekends along with two combined weekends. The two-cycle weekends will now become double-header weekends giving Rotax racers more race time. This makes for a five race four-cycle series and an eight race two-cycle series spread over eight weekends. The biggest change of note is the addition of Innisfil Indy Go Karts of Gilford, Ontario to the schedule. The Innisfil Indy location is going through several changes before the season gets underway, and hosting two rounds of the BSRKC is a great way to celebrate the new look at Innisfil Indy.

"The entire committee have worked hard to finalize the 2010 schedule," comments Enzo Chiovitti, Simcoe Kart Club President and BSRKC Principal. "We had to make some last minute changes and I think the final version looks very good. We tried very hard to add a variety of tracks to the program, but were unable to accommodate any date changes. We are looking forward to hosting two dates at Innisfil Indy."

The season will kick off at 3-S Go Karts in Sutton for the first split weekend featuring four-cycle classes only in single race event format. Then the series kicks off the first of two consecutive two-cycle only weekends. The first will be a double-header weekend at Kawartha Downs Speedway. The event will be running on the Sunday and Monday of the Holiday weekend to accommodate easier paddock access. Then the BSRKC series will hit Innisfil Indy for a second two-cycle double header on a repaved and extended track.

"We are very excited to have the BSRKC back here at Innisfil Indy Go Karts," comments Innisfil Indy owner Tony Launi. "We ran a race the first year and with all the changes we are making, it is very nice to have the series return to Innisfil Indy. The racing will be very good and of course Rose will have the kitchen open."

Next up the BSRKC will bring four-cycle and two-cycle racers together for a summer celebration of karting at Point Pelee Karting in Leamington, located in the southwest corner of the province. Up next will be a four-cycle only event at the road/oval course of Flamboro Speedway hosted by the Waterloo Kart Club. Hitting the mid point of summer, the annual trek to Shannonville will take place as the series spreads its wings across the province to the east. This five-day festival of karting will again award the coveted Bear trophies for all Grand National classes. With summer heading to an end, the BSRKC crew will invade Innisfil Indy for a second time to run a four-cycle only, single event weekend. The final race of the year will be a double-header two-cycle weekend at 3-S Go Karts, taking the BSRKC road show full circle as the series crowns its champions.

Supplemental rules are now being completed with several unique features. Based on driver feedback from the tentative schedule posted several months ago, the series will award 100 bonus points to drivers who complete all the scheduled races in their class. This replaces the idea of double points in the final four-cycle or final two-cycle events. The full set of supplemental regulations will be posted at the BSRKC website shortly.
