BSRKC May 22 and May 23 Race 1 Preview

Season begins at 3-S Go Karts in Sutton

Race 1 of the 2011 Brian Stewart Racing Karting Championship Series hosted by the Simcoe Kart Club takes place this Sunday, May 22 and Monday, May 23 at 3-S Go Karts in Sutton. Practice is available all week and is free for all 3-S annual track members. The cost for non members is \$50.00 and paid when you practice. Saturday is the official practice day. The classes competing on Sunday are: Junior Medium, Mini Max, Rotax/TaG Junior, Rotax/TaG Senior, DD2 and ICC/Moto. Open practice will follow immediately after Sunday's races until 8:30 pm. The cost for non 3-S track members is \$30.00. The classes competing on Monday are: Novice, Junior Lite, Junior Heavy, Senior Lite, Senior Heavy and Masters. The entry fee for all racers is \$85.00 per class. The practice, parking (if applicable), and entry fees are paid to 3-S Go Karts by way of cash or cheques.

The sponsors this weekend are Canadian Insurance Brokers Inc., Cavalier Logistics, 401 Mini-Indy Limited and 401 Dixie Nissan/Infiniti. All classes with 10+ entries receive cash prizes. 1st place receives \$175.00, 2nd place receives \$75.00, and 3rd place receives \$50.00. All cash prizes are awarded the same day at trophy presentations. The names of all of the entrants are included in the special draws. The special draws also take place both days at trophy presentations.
