### **BSRKC Race 3 Preview**

*The excitement continues as the Series hits Flamboro Speedway*

With two races completed the Brian Stewart Series competitors converge on Flamboro Speedway Saturday July 9 and Sunday, July 10 for what will likely be the best attended karting event of the 2011 season.

The track will be open for the official practice on Friday, July 8 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. The cost for practice is \$50.00. Please note that there will be no open practice at the conclusion of Saturday's races.

On Saturday racing will start at 8:00 am. Saturday's classes include Rotax Mini Max, Rotax/TaG Junior, Rotax/TaG Senior, and the 4 stroke Junior Medium class. The Series is pleased to announce that the Honda Senior Medium class has been added to the Saturday schedule.

On Sunday racing will start at 9:00 am. Sunday's classes are Cadet, Novice, Junior Lite, Junior Heavy, Senior Lite, Senior Heavy, Masters and ICC/Moto.

The racing will surely be intense as the Waterloo Regional Kart Club anticipates record attendance at this event as the competition is so close between the top five in almost every class. With only two more races left in the Series after Flamboro, the WRKC members will be ready to take advantage of their home track advantage. Participation is crucial for any competitor that has an eye on one of more BSRKC Championship titles.

It is important that all competitors note that there is no overnight camping at the racetrack. It will be possible to leave trailers in the pits on Friday evening, however there will be no security provided by the Series. On Saturday, all competitors must vacate the pit area by 3:00 pm. On Saturday evening, Flamboro Speedway is hosting the Dan May Memorial race, featuring the Can-Am Midgets, Canadian Vintage Modifieds, Mini Stocks and F4 Modifieds. It will be an exciting night for all spectators and race fans.

All classes with ten or more entries will receive cash prizes. First place receives \$175.00, second place receives \$75.00, and third place receives \$50.00. The cash prizes will be awarded the same day as the trophy presentations. As is the case with all kart racing events held at Flamboro Speedway, the top five in each class will also receive trophies. There will be special draw prizes at the trophy presentation on both race days and all registered drivers will be eligible for the prize draws.
